Project Overview

- Remove existing reservoir covers which are no longer serviceable
- Install reservoir liners to increase the useful volume of the reservoirs
 - Additional 3 MG of treated water storage
 - Increased reliability during peak demand
 - Better serve new customers in MST and LCWD

 Install new reservoir covers after completion of this project (not included in this contract)
