



MST Recycled Water Service


- Milliken-Sarco-Tulocay (MST) region has been identified as a groundwater deficient zone
- Recycled water has been provided to reduce groundwater withdrawals – promoting sustainable use






MST Recycled Water Service

 - MST Truck Fill Station 2019














Potential Users

 MST Sphere users without access to the RW main




