
Project Goals

- Improve level of service






Pre-Project Conditions

- 3. Redesign project scope



Proposed Schedule

Open Bids	January 2019
Award Contract	March 2019 (early)
Notice to Proceed	March 2019 (late)
Start Construction	May 2019
Complete Construction	Fall 2020



CIP Budget Impacts

- Increase in construction cost (\$4.7 million)
 - \$1 million in first 2 years
 - \$1 million in years 3-10 (\$130k per year)
 - \$2.7 million in years 11-30 (\$130k per year)

Delay of other scheduled projects



Proposed Project to Delay

- Treatment Plant Project 2020
 - \$2.4 million total budget
 - 3W system; plant piping and valve replacement
 - Delay less critical replacement work until 2021



Recommendation

Award construction contact to JMB Construction in the amount of \$23,331,631 and authorize the General Manager to issue Notice to Proceed for the Browns Valley Trunk Project (CIP 14703), when appropriate.
