


Background

- 15,400 LF (~3 mi. length)
- 66" RCP unlined
- Criticality
 - Conveys over 90% of flow to SWRF
 - Parallels the Napa River
 - No redundancy




Condition Assessment Results





Project Scope



- Structural rehabilitation (CIPP) of downstream 1.3 miles of trunk main (south of Kaiser Road)
- Manhole construction / reconstruction / replacement to facilitate liner installation
