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RESOLUTION OF THE BOARD OF DIRECTORS OF THE NAPA SANTATION DISTRICT TO AUTHORIZE CONTINUATION OF THE DISTRICT'S LOW INCOME PROPERTY OWNER REBATE PROGRAM

RECITALS

WHEREAS, the Board of Directors adopted Ordinance No. 84, which implemented a sewer service rebate for low income property owners, which was later codified as District Code 5.01.020; and

WHEREAS, Resolution 09-005, adopted May 6, 2009, established policies and procedures for the District's Low Income Property Owner Rebate program; and

WHEREAS, the formula used for the rebate was restated in Board Resolution 16-003 on March 16, 2016, setting the rebate at 28% of the sewer service charge; and

WHEREAS, Resolution 19-007, adopted May 1, 2019, modified the eligibility requirements for the District's Low Income Property Owner Rebate Program to allow enrollment in the PG&E CARE program to be considered adequate evidence of financial need and proof of income eligibility; and

WHEREAS, with the modification in sewer service charges considered by the Board on March 31, 2021, for Fiscal Years 2021/22 through 2025/26, the Board wishes to continue the Low Income Property Owner Rebate Program; and

WHEREAS, the maximum sewer service charges will remain at \$738.60 in FY 2021/22 through FY 2025/26, the formula used for the rebate will also remain the same at 28% of the sewer service charge; and

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, that the Board of Directors of the Napa Sanitation District hereby authorizes the continuation of the District's Low Income Property Owner Rebate Program and incorporates the reference of this resolution to the policies and procedures.
