8. **REGULAR CALENDAR:**

a. Receive presentation from staff on NapaSan's new NPDES permit adopted February 9, 2022 by the Regional Water Quality Control Board.

Tim Healy, General Manager, introduced consultant Monica Oakley. Ms. Oakley gave a presentation to the Board on the highlights of NapaSan's new NPDES (National Pollutant Discharge Elimination System) Permit that was adopted by the Regional Water Quality Control Board on February 9, 2022. She reported the permit effective date is April 1, 2022 and will expire on March 31, 2027.

Ms. Oakley reviewed the notable changes from NapaSan's previous permit, including the constituents with effluent limits and monitoring frequency changes. She reported that some of the changes in the new permit will result in significant savings to the District. The successful NPDES permit adoption was a team effort between NapaSan staff and Ms. Oakley. The Board and staff held discussion.

Karl Ono, Associate Engineer, gave a presentation on the completion of the 66-inch trunk sewer main rehabilitation project. The project scope included structural rehabilitation (CIPP) of 1.3 miles of trunk main south of Kaiser Road. Ono reviewed the background and condition of the pipeline prior to the project, and the construction process which included a 2.2 mile bypass line, excavation work and approximately 7,100 feet of CIPP pipe lining.

Ono reviewed the project costs and change order summary (7.5% of original contract). The total project contract cost with change orders is \$6,040,840. Change order costs included installation of an additional manhole replacement, cure water filtration, additional trail restoration work, pipeline length discrepancies and additional bypass trenching. Ono reviewed lessons learned on the project and upcoming efforts relating to the trunk sewer line, including a phase II project from

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Imola Avenue to Kaiser Road (1.65 miles) slated for construction in 2028/29. Ono reported that the project will be featured at the 2022 NASTT No-Dig Show in Minneapolis, Minnesota. The Board and staff held discussion.
