RELATIONSHIP TO POLICY

All investments are consistent with the County Investment Policy. There is sufficient liquidity to cover all anticipated cash flow needs for the pool participants for the next 6 months.

- 1. Safety There are NO at risk investments in the portfolio.
- 2. Liquidity 16.6% of the portfolio matures within 90 days. \$19,350,000.00 are available on a daily basis and \$294,461,218.79 could be liquidated at a profit.
- 3. Maximization Interest maximization is consistent with safety, liquidity and cashflow considerations.

Investment vehicles used during the month of October 2005 were : Agencies of the Federal Government, Certificates of Deposit, Commercial Paper, LAIF, and Teeter Notes.

The weighted average days to maturity was 622 days.

There were no "when issued" trading nor were there any swaps of securities.

No reverse repo's and no securites lending.
