**RE:** Inglewood Village Water Agreement Amendment; Continued Discussion;



## **BACKGROUND**

Inglewood Village is located at the corner of Inglewood Avenue and Highway 29, (Assessor's Parcel Nos. 027-120-040 and 027-120-050) outside the City Limits and is currently a customer of the St. Helena Water Enterprise. In 2000, Inglewood was granted a use permit by the County of Napa that required a Water Use Agreement with the City of St. Helena to provide the property owner, up to 538,740 gallons of water per year. The water agreement was entered into on April 19, 2000 and recorded on July 21, 2003.

Representatives of the property informed the City that they currently have a use permit application before Napa County to add a fourth structure on the west side of the property. The 4,092 square foot administrative building would hold a maximum of 16 additional employees and generate an additional consumption of 52,136 gallons per year. The additional use would result in a use of only 67 percent of the amount approved in the current water agreement.

The County of Napa will not complete the use permit process without acknowledgement from the City that the water is or will be made available to the property.

# **DISCUSSION**

At its September 27<sup>th</sup> regularly scheduled meeting the City Council considered request for an amendment to the agreement to include the 4<sup>th</sup> building. At that meeting it was proposed to that the total water allocation in the agreement might be reduced to less than the current amount because the applicants own water use calculations indicate their need is 67% of the current amount. The discussion then turned to center on the number of approved buildings and whether or not the City might be reneging on the current agreement.

The matter was continued until more information could be made available to the Council for their consideration. The additional information requested is as follows:

- 1. Information regarding Use Permit 99077 from Napa County for the Inglewood Village project.
- 2. Staff Report that accompanied the Water Agreement to City Council back in 2000.
- 3. Any water calculations that support the current approved amount.
- 4. Minutes from the meeting that adopted the current agreement.

The information, if available, is presented herein:

1. The Conditions of Approval for County Use Permit #99077UP specifically state:

*The Permit is limited to:* 

- a. The establishment of a commercial office complex for general business offices, including professional, executive, financial, real estate, and insurance offices; as delineated on the attached approved site plan and consistent with the application forms.
- b. The establishment of a retail nursery and garden center, including a maximum 43,300 ft<sup>2</sup> of outdoor garden display area.
- c. The construction of three commercial structures, as delineated on the approved site plan: Building "A", single story 3,575 ft<sup>2</sup> in area; Building "B", single-story 4,030 ft<sup>2</sup> in area; and Building "C", two-story, 15,283 ft<sup>2</sup> in area.

The site plan with the 3 buildings, sizes as shown are the same as shown in the Exhibit attached to the current water agreement and reflect what was constructed on-site.

- 2. The Staff Report that accompanied the agreement was not located. A copy is not available.
- 3. Water calculations for the original agreement were not located and also not available.
- 4. The minutes from the City Council meeting that approved the agreement are as follows:

Councilmember Toller moved to adopt Resolution No. 2000-57 approving a Water Agreement with Leticia Mori Kartozian and Suzzette Mori Toma (Inglewood Village) located at the corner of Highway 29 and Inglewood Avenue. The motion was seconded by Councilmember Potter and on roll call carried by the following vote:

ABSENT: Councilmember Bowers

City Staff and the property proponent met subsequent to the collection of the above data. The project proponent has volunteered to accept a lesser volume of water with an amended agreement.

The project proponent has offered to reduce the overall total to 84% of the current allotment. This provides the project with 125% of the volume estimated by their water calculations. The new approved volume of water will be 452,542 gallons a year; current agreement is 538,740 gallons per year.

The amendment should also include an exhibit that includes all four buildings on the property.

### **IMPACTS**

Staff has reviewed the historical water usage of the site and the Director of Public Works and City Engineer confirms that the proposal would not have a negative impact on the City's water supply.

#### **RECOMMENDATION**

Based on the documentation provided, staff recommends that an amended agreement to include the revised total volume and the revised site plan be approved by resolution.

#### **RECITALS**

- A. Inglewood Village is located at the corner of Inglewood Avenue and Highway 29, outside the City Limits and is currently a customer of the St. Helena Water Enterprise. In 2000, the owners of Inglewood Village were granted a use permit by the County of Napa that required a Water Use Agreement with the City of St. Helena to provide the property owner, up to 538,740 gallons of water per year.
- B. On May 23, 2003, Resolution 2000-57 approved the water agreement and was entered into on April 19, 2000 and recorded on July 21, 2003; and
- C. Representatives of the property informed the City that they currently have a use permit application before Napa County to add a fourth structure on the west side of the property. The 4,092 square foot administrative building would hold a maximum of 16 additional employees and generate an additional consumption of 52,136 gallons per year. The additional use would result in a use of only 67 percent of the amount approved in the current water agreement.; and
