Both of these files should be read.

Strategy for filling out this form:

- 1) Completely fill out the Introduction worksheet. Read this section and the Notes section below. Read the top portion of each work sheet before filling in your data.
- 2) Fill out worksheets for Questions 1 through 4 completely first. This will save you time on the Data Page. (If you fill out Questions 1 through 4 correctly, you need only focus on the grapes you purchased from the original grower and the grapes you grew yourself and then crushed at your firm.
- 3) Next start with the Data Page. Questions 1C, 3 and 4 data are subtotaled into the Data Page. Some information entered into these three questions does not need to be re-entered onto the Data Page. This is different than in previous years and applies to this 2011 workbook version of the Grape Crush Inquiry form only--not the paper version.
- 4) If you have resold grapes (Question 1B), enter the purchase information for these grapes only into Section II of the Data Page worksheet. This is the original purchase from grower information. Enter nothing into Section 1.
- 5) If grapes you purchased from growers were crushed by another processor, enter the purchase information for these grapes only into Section II of the Data Page worksheet. Enter nothing into Section 1.
- 6) Fill in BOTH Data Page Sections I and II for grapes you purchased from the original grower and also crushed at your facility.
- 7) Fill in only Data Page Section I for the grapes you grew and also crushed at your facility. Enter nothing into Section II. For these grapes you must enter a 1 into Data Page column C for your assessment to calculate correctly.
- 8) Go to Section A and fill in the white cells as needed to balance and check your workbook totals. Note any errors message and correct the problem.
- 9) Go to Section B and check the district totals. (This page is automatically filled in for you.) Note any error messages and correct the problem.
- 10) Go to Balance Districts and check the district subtotals. (This page is automatically filled in for you.) Note any errors and correct the problem. If there are errors in red, your assessment may not calculate correctly.
- 11) Go to Balance Varieties and check the variety subtotals. (This page is automatically filled in for you.) Note any errors and correct the problem. If there are errors in red, your assessment may not calculate correctly.
- 12) Go to the Assessment Totals worksheet and look for errors. (This page is automatically filled in for you.)
- 13) In the Assessment Totals worksheet, indicate if you will receive any late crush tonnage.
- 14) Go back through each worksheet in this workbook and look for errors. Errors and omissions are in red cells. Suspiciously large or small values are green.

If you are systematic, it makes filling out this workbook much easier. Try to keep grapes of differing histories separate. Do not average grapes with differing histories together. This makes it difficult for us and you to resolve any issues later. For example if you do something like averaging your resold grapes in with your purchased grapes that you crushed for yourself, it would make it difficult to isolate and examine these resold grapes later when trying to resolve, say, an error in your assessment calculations.

General Notes:

The small red triangle like the one to the left here is an embedded comment. Put your mouse arrow over it to display.

Sometimes a cell will turn red like this. This indicates that there is an error caused by a missing or an invalid worksheet cell value. When finished you should see no red cells. (Note: If the worksheet is damaged, the red error shading may not go away no matter what value you type--see cutting, copying and pasting below.)

Sometimes a cell will turn green like this. This indicates that there is a suspicious cell value.

Check that you have typed the number in the cell correctly. Enter tonnages to the tenth—prices to the cent.

Every line you enter in this workbook needs a variety name, district number, tonnage and weighted average degrees brix.

Please spell the variety names as they are spelled here in the Varieties worksheet. Doing so will allow your Pierce's Disease Assessment to calculate; otherwise, it will be in error or simply will not calculate.

The worksheets in this workbook are protected to prevent accidental damage to the formulas.

Be careful with the cut and past features—they can damage this workbook if not used as described here.

You may type your data within the white boxes on these worksheets. (The white areas outside of the colored worksheets are protected.) If you type in any other cell or box, a warning will display stating that what you have just typed will not be accepted. The workbook will not allow you to insert or to delete lines neither will it allow you to add or remove sheets. If more lines are needed, please download a larger workbook.

If you need your own protection for sharing this file, please read below.

Below are some general guidelines in the use of the cut, copy, and paste features for this workbook. Following these guidelines will preserve this workbook's features and formulas.

Never cut—it can damage this workbook.

If you need to delete entries, highlight the information you want to erase and press the delete key. Never click on "Cut" or press Ctrl-X.

Copying cells is always okay.

Never do a simple paste—it can damage this workbook.

Paste instructions:

- 1) Copy what you wish to paste.
- 2) Right-click your mouse in the cell where you wish to paste what you just copied.
- 3) A popup menu will appear. Click on "Paste Special" within this popup.
- 4) A small window will appear titled "Paste Special." Within this window, select the "Values" item and then click the OK button.

Done. Never click on the usual "Paste" or press Ctrl-V. Always use "Paste Special."

Damaged Workbook?

If your workbook becomes damaged from cutting or improper pasting, you may not be able to clear the red error messages by simply typing in the correct value for the cell.
