Hi Chris,

Happy New Year! Thank you for circulating the draft MND for the subject project. Here is my only comment:

The MND discusses a Permit Exception to allow the encroachment of access drives into required stream setbacks. Acreage-specific potential impacts to riparian habitats, should be identified and discussed, and mitigation measures necessary to offset those impacts should be included. For any activity that will divert or obstruct the natural flow, or change the bed, channel, or bank (which may include associated riparian resources) of a stream, or use material from a streambed, DFG will require a Lake and Streambed Alteration Agreement (LSAA), pursuant to Section 1600 et seq. of the Fish and Game Code, with the applicant. Issuance of an LSAA is subject to CEQA. DFG, as a responsible agency under CEQA, will consider the CEQA document for the project. The CEQA document should fully identify the potential impacts to the stream or riparian resources and provide adequate avoidance, mitigation, monitoring and reporting commitments for completion of the agreement.
