# LMR Rutherford Estate Winery - Negative Declaration

Thank you for including the California Department of Transportation (Caltrans) in the application review process for the project referenced above. We have reviewed the Negative Declaration and have the following comments to offer.

## Traffic Safety

Two of the Traffic Safety comments per Caltrans' letter dated November 15, 2007 (attached) were not addressed in the Traffic Impact Report (TIR) dated January 13, 2014. Comment #2 stated, "The existing two-way left turn lane (TWLTL) would provide about 50 feet of storage for southbound (SB) left turn ingress to the proposed driveway. This is insufficient for deceleration. The TWLTL needs to be lengthened to safely accommodate deceleration for the left turn ingress to the project. Please refer to Caltrans' Highway Design Manual, Index 405.2". Comment #3 stated, "An 8-foot shoulder width needs to provided along the project's frontage." Neither of these comments was reflected in the TIR.

Furthermore, the TIR should include an analysis of a 100-guest event. Additionally, the TIR should provide a schematic figure illustrating the project's traffic volume.

#### Highway Operations

The TIR uses a range of 2-3% for truck volumes during the harvest season. These percentages underestimate the presence of trucks. According to the 2011 truck volume data, truck volumes are actually in the 6-7% range.

On page 18 of Appendix C, the posted speed limit is 50mph, not 55mph.

Were any other driveway configurations considered? Specifically, the relative position of the new driveway into LMR, in relation to the existing Grgich Hills access driveway.

How much traffic will be generated by construction of the new site (page 18) and how will this traffic impact SR 29?
