Important information regarding your refuse and recycling collection during the holidays:

If you need an extra refuse or recycling bag picked up, please call our office one day before service to authorize the charge, 963-7988 8am-4:30pm.

We do not accept Styrofoam, ribbons or bows in the blue recycling cart. Please reuse these items or place in your brown refuse cart. Be sure Styrofoam peanuts are placed in a plastic bag and tied or knotted.

* Place wrapping paper and greeting cards in your blue recycling cart.

String lighting that no longer works can be placed in your blue recycling cart or dropped at the e-waste area at Clover Flat.

 Christmas Trees can be placed in your green waste cart, however, trees must be cut into 3ft sections.
 We cannot pick up whole trees as they will get stuck behind the blade of our truck.

* Christmas Trees can also be recycled free of charge at Clover Flat Resource Recovery Park. They

will accept your tree free of charge through January 22nd. *(See facility hours on page 2.)*

Do not place hot or warm ash in carts or containers. Be sure fireplace and cooking ash is cold before disposing.

 * As a friendly reminder, all cart lids must close flat for collection.
 This is to ensure that debris will not spill out and litter the community. If you require an additional pick up, please call our office in advance. NEW!

Recycle your cooking oil. Clover Flat Resource Recovery Park offers free drop off of cooking oil. Maximum drop off is 10 gallons per trip. Please check in with attendant.
