No. 6131 with Environmental Science Associates (ESA) for preparation of a CEQA Document

assocated with Erosion Control Plan Application #01278-ECPA.

RECOMMENDATION

Director of Conservation, Development and Planning requests approval of and authorization for the Chair to sign Amendment No. 1 to Agreement No. 6131 with Environmental Science Associates increasing the amount by \$30,767 for a new maximum of \$92,512 for preparation of the California Environmental Quality Act document for Erosion Control Plan Application #01278-ECPA for Capell Valley Vineyards. (Assessor's Parcel Nos. 032-130-008 and 032-130-044)

BACKGROUND AND DISCUSSION

This request for a first amendment to Napa County Agreement No. 6131 allows for the preparation of supporting technical studies (a wetland delineation and a red-legged frog assessment) for the CEQA document associated with Erosion Control Plan Application #01278-ECPA for an approximately 46 acre new vineyard to be located on 2 contiguous parcels of approximately 219 acres in total. The work scope of this amendment are for 2 resources (potential jurisdictional wetland and potential red-legged frog habitat) which require site specific studies.
