## RECOMMENDATION

Chief Information Officer requests approval of and authorization for the Chair to sign an agreement with Dell Computer Corporation for a maximum of \$15,420 for the term January 30, 2007 through August 30, 2007 for software and training.

## EXECUTIVE SUMMARY

The proposed agreement is for Dell Computer Corporation to install and conduct training at a County facility for County employees on VMware Infrastructure software.

#### BACKGROUND AND DISCUSSION

The proposed agreement with Dell Computer Corporation (Dell) provides software conversion tools and a 'Jumpstart' training package for VMware. VMware allows more software to run on each server saving money on server purchases over time. VMware also enhances business continuity and disaster recovery processes. Vmware 'Jumpstart' training offers hands on training in the County environment for a faster implementation of this product utilizing industry best practices.

Dell offered this training under the WSCA Contract with the State of California. Dell assigns a certified VMware instructor for this training.
