First reading and intention to adopt an ordinance Amending Sections 18.16.030 and 18.20.030 (To Allow Certain Small Agricultural Processing Facilities in the Agricultural Preserve (AP) and Agricultural Watershed (AW) Zoning Districts Upon Grant of a Use Permit) and Section 18.104.090 (To Allow Storage, Warehousing and Manufacturing of Less Than 200 Gallons of Wine Under a Home Occupation Permit); adding new Sections 18.104.400 (Hot Air Balloon Launching Site - Findings) and 18.116.043 (Signs For Viticulture-Based 501(c)(3) Non-Profit Environmental Associations Representing Appellation Specific Geographical Locations); amending Section 18.120.010 (To Allow Balloon Launching Sites in any Zone Upon Grant of a Use Permit); and amending Sections 18.126.030 and 18.126.060 (Relating To Issuance of Administrative Permits For Signs) of the Napa County Code.
