SUBJECT:	Amendment No. 2 to Agreement No. 767 with Silverado Avionics, Inc.

RECOMMENDATION

Director of Public Works/Aviation requests approval of and authorization for the Chair to sign Amendment No. 2 to Agreement No. 767 with Silverado Avionics, Inc. extending the term through May 31, 2007 for the business of aviation electronics.

EXECUTIVE SUMMARY

Lease Agreement No 767, with Silverado Avionics, Inc. expires November 30, 2006. Approval of Amendment No. 2 is being requested to provide sufficient time for discussions between Silverado Avionics and its current sublessee Bridgeford Flying Services to develop an appropriate agreement that ensures services that benefit the airport clients. All other terms will remain the same during the requested six month extension.

ENVIRONMENTAL IMPACT

BACKGROUND AND DISCUSSION

On November 24, 1992 the Board of Supervisors approved Lease Agreement No. 767 between the County of Napa and Silverado Avionics, Inc. to lease .867 acres of the improved premises located at the Napa County Airport to engage in the business of aviation electronics for a basic term of seven years commencing on December 1, 1992 and expiring on November 30, 1999. In 1999, the lessee exercised its option to extend the lease for an additional seven years to November 30, 2006. The First Amendment to Lease No. 767 was approved on May 3, 1994 in which the County consented for a portion of the improved premises to be subleased. The requested action extends the lease until May 31, 2007.
