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### **RECOMMENDATION**

Director of Conservation, Development and Planning and County Counsel request adoption of a resolution rescinding Resolution No. 92-102 and adopting new procedures for processing General Plan Amendments.

### **EXECUTIVE SUMMARY**

In 1992, the Board adopted Resolution No. 92-102 which established procedures for processing General Plan Amendments. Over the past 13 years, the County has reviewed and processed several General Plan Amendments and determined that some of the original procedures in Resolution No. 92-102 need to be updated to provide greater flexibility and efficiency.

### **BACKGROUND AND DISCUSSION**

In 1992, the Board adopted Resolution No. 92-102 which established procedures for processing General Plan Amendments. Over the past 13 years, the County has reviewed and processed several General Plan Amendments and determined that some of the original procedures in Resolution No. 92-102 need to be updated to provide greater flexibility and efficiency. The proposed resolution rescinds Resolution No. 92-102 and creates new procedures by way of consolidating some duplicative procedures, allowing County initiated General Plan Amendments to be filed at any time during the year instead of only in the month of March and clarifying that an EIR determination on a General Plan Amendment may be made by the Planning Director without preparation of an Initial Study.
