SUBJECT: Approve Agreement for AMS.NET telephone maintenance

RECOMMENDATION

Acting Chief Information Officer requests approval of and authorization for the Chair to sign an agreement with AMS.NET, Inc. for a maximum of \$20,000 for the term September 1, 2007 through June 30, 2008 for Voice over Internet Protocol (VoIP) telephone system maintenance and repair services.

EXECUTIVE SUMMARY

This is a maintenance agreement with AMS.NET to provide vital maintenance and repair services for the County's Voice over Internet Protocol (VoIP) Telephone system. These services cover both the software and hardware components of the system.

ENVIRONMENTAL IMPACT

ENVIRONMENTAL DETERMINATION: The proposed action is not a project as defined by 14 California Code of Regulations 15378 (State CEQA Guidelines) and therefore CEQA is not applicable.

BACKGROUND AND DISCUSSION

The County Voice over Internet Protocol (VoIP) telephone system is currently being operated in 27 departments, with the system processing an average of 15,000 calls per business day. Three more departments are to be added to this system within the current fiscal year. Once complete, the VoIP system will supply 90% of the County's telephone services.

On June 14, 2005, the Board approved Agreement No. 6449 with AMS.NET for Voice over Internet Protocol telephone system maintenance and repair services for a maximum of \$13,000. At that time the system was being operated in 13 departments across the County.

On July 11, 2006, the Board approved an amendment to the agreement for a new maximum of \$40,636 of which \$20,000 was for VoIP telephone system maintenance and repair services. At that time the system was being operated in 22 departments.

This new agreement is necessary to use the County's standard Professional Services Agreement and separate the maintenance and support services costs out of the old agreement which included purchasing the VoIP system from a different vendor.

VoIP is a critical communication system. If this system were to fail, certain operations would be suspended. It is crucial to have the proper maintenance and support available to the County.
