Napa School of Music provides music lessons to children in the Health and Human Services Agency's Child Welfare Services SB 163 Wraparound Program. Approval of the amendment incorporates Addenda to the Scope of Work and Compensation exhibits to include additional music lesson services this fiscal year. The increase in the rate will be absorbed within the existing contract maximum.
