RECOMMENDATION

Agricultural Commissioner/Sealer of Weights and Measures requests approval of and authorization for the Chair to sign renewal of revenue Agreement No. 180052B with the California Agricultural Commissioners and Sealers Association (CACASA) for a maximum of \$10,056 for the term July 1, 2019 through June 30, 2020 for services related to submitting pesticide use reporting data.

EXECUTIVE SUMMARY

Renewal of revenue Agreement No. 180052B reimburses the County for preparation and submission of pesticide use reporting data. The agreement allows CACASA to reimburse the County for time expended by staff collecting, reviewing, and electronically entering pesticide use report information into a statewide database.

BACKGROUND AND DISCUSSION

Revenue Agreement No. 180052B provides for reimbursement of costs associated with the Agricultural Commissioner's collecting, reviewing, and electronically entering pesticide use report information and subsequent transferring of data for use by the California Department of Pesticide Regulation as required by Title 3, sections 6624 through 6628 of the California Code of Regulations and Food & Agricultural Code section 12979.
