BACKGROUND AND DISCUSSION

The purpose of the Napa County Child Care Planning Council is to assess Napa County child care needs and to develop plans to address those needs. The Council is committed to meeting the child care and development needs of children and families, through education, coordinated planning and advocacy efforts. The Council believes that all children in Napa County have the right to experience a safe, healthy and nurturing childhood with equal access to community services and support.

The goals of the Council are as follows;

- Advocate for increased availability, affordability, and accessibility of quality childcare;
- Increase opportunities to educate the community about child care and development issues; and,
- Foster public-private partnerships designed to meet local child care needs.
