SUBJECT: Amendment No. 3 to Agreement No. 3370 with R.A. Bridgeford, Inc.

RECOMMENDATION

Director of Public Works/Aviation requests approval of and authorization for the Chair to sign Amendment No. 3 to Agreement No. 3370 with R.A. Bridgeford, Inc. extending the term through May 31, 2006 for retail aviation fuel services.

EXECUTIVE SUMMARY

Fuel Management Agreement No 3370, with the County's "Fuel Manager" R.A. Bridgeford, dba Bridgeford Flying Services (BFS), expires December 1, 2005. Staff recommends approval of Amendment No. 3 of Napa County Agreement No. 3370 which extends the term of the agreement for an additional six months commencing on May 31, 2006.

BACKGROUND AND DISCUSSION

Fuel Management Agreement No. 3370, with the County's "Fuel Manager" R. A. Bridgeford, dba Bridgeford Flying Services (BFS), expired May 31, 2005. Amendment No. 2 was approved on May 24, 2005 in order to provide staff time to work with BFS and the Airport Advisory Commission in developing a new agreement. While progress has been made during the extension time period, an second six month extension is being requested to allow Bridgeford Flying Services and staff additional time to complete work on the agreement.

The agreement for contract fuel services has worked well for both parties over the past 12 years (four - 3 year agreements). It has allowed BFS to provide retail aviation fueling services and to operate as a full-service Fixed Base Operator at the County Airport. With repayment of the 1990 Certificates of Participation, restrictions associated with financing have been lifted, and different agreement provisions may be warranted. The six month extension allows the present retail aviation fuel services to be provided without interruption to the airport's clients.
