RECOMMENDATION

Director of Public Works requests acceptance of a donation in the amount of \$1,000 from Maddie's Fund to the Napa County Animal Shelter and approval for the Chairman to sign a letter of appreciation.

EXECUTIVE SUMMARY

In accordance with Board Resolution No. 05-40 and the Recommended Procedure for the Acceptance and Disbursement of Gifts, Bequests, or Devices for donations in excess of \$1,000, this agenda item has been prepared to accept a donation in the amount of \$1,000 from Maddie's Fund and to send a letter of appreciation for their generous contribution.
