SUBJECT: Approval of renewal of Agreements Numbers 4339 and 4168.

RECOMMENDATION

Agricultural Commissioner/Sealer of Weights and Measures requests approval of and authorization for the Chair to sign renewals of the following revenue agreements with the California Department of Food and Agriculture:

1. Agreement No. 4339 for a maximum of \$423,577 for the term July 1, 2006 through June 30, 2007 for reimbursement of expenditures for activities related to the Glassy-winged Sharpshooter program; and
2. Agreement No. 4168 for a maximum of \$77,740 for the term July 1, 2006 through June 30, 2007 for reimbursement of expenditures for activities related to the Olive Fruit Fly Trapping and Pest Detection Trapping services.

BACKGROUND AND DISCUSSION

Agreement No. 4339 provides for the reimbursement of costs from California Department of Food and Agriculture (CDFA) associated with the detection and exclusion of the Glassy-winged Sharpshooter. This agreement allocates \$423,577 to perform these activities as required.

Agreement No. 4168 provides for the reimbursement of costs from CDFA associated with insect detection trapping in Napa County for Olive Fruit Fly, Mediterranean, Oriental and Melon fruit flies, Gypsy Moth and Japanese beetles. This agreement allocates \$77,740 to perform these activities as required.
