### ENVIRONMENTAL IMPACT

### BACKGROUND AND DISCUSSION

There is one opening on the Wildlife Conservation Commission (WCC) due to the resignation of the Conservation, Development, and Planning Commission representative, David Graves. At their meeting on October 19, 2006, the

Napa County Conservation, Development, and Planning Commission unanimously nominated newly appointed Commissioner Heather Phillips to fill the vacant position.

The purpose of the WCC is to advise the Board of Supervisors on how funds, including the percentage of Fish and Game fines received by Napa County, should be expended for the preservation, propagation and protection of birds, mammals, fish and amphibians.

The WCC consists of eight members appointed by the Board of Supervisors. The eight members are comprised of four citizen representatives, one sportsperson-angler, one wildlife-conservation representative, one youth, and one Conservation, Development, and Planning Commission representative.
