RECOMMENDATION

County Counsel requests approval of and authorization for the Chair to sign an agreement with Thomson Reuters for a maximum amount of \$12,132 for the term February 1, 2020 through January 31, 2021, with two annual renewals and a 2% increase each subsequent year to provide Westlaw legal research software.

EXECUTIVE SUMMARY

County Counsel requires the use of legal research software to have access to the most recent statutes and case law, as well as other research sources. Thomson Reuters provides Westlaw legal research software that fulfills that need.

ENVIRONMENTAL DETERMINATION: The proposed action is not a project as defined by 14 California Code of Regulations 15378 (State CEQA Guidelines) and therefore CEQA is not applicable.

BACKGROUND AND DISCUSSION

County Counsel has substantially reduced the size of its print library over the last five years and replaced it with online subscriptions to legal research software. Thomson Reuters is able to provide Westlaw legal research software at a savings over the previous provider of legal research software.

The County has two existing agreements with Thomson Reuters - Agreement no. 170385B that provides Westlaw legal research software to Child Support Services and Agreement no. 200206B that provides ProLaw case management software and services to County Counsel. Per the County's purchasing policy, service contracts that exceed three years must be approved by the Board of Supervisors.
