Greg Pirie retires on December 20, 2018 after more than 24 years of admirable public service with Napa County.

BACKGROUND AND DISCUSSION

Greg Pirie retires from Napa County on December 20th after more than 24 years of service. He began his career in

1994 as a Senior Registered Environmental Health Specialist in the County Administrators Office. Greg then became the Local Enforcement Agency Coordinator, and finally the Solid Waste Program Manager in the Environmental Health Division of the Department of Planning, Building & Environmental Services. During his tenure, he implemented the waste tire enforcement grant program, body art and medical waste compliance program, permitted and inspected landfills, compost, and transfer station operations, and created multiple long-term solid waste franchise agreements.
