### **RECOMMENDATION**

Interim Director of Health and Human Services requests authorization to accept a donation to the Children's Trust Fund in the Health and Human Services Agency from an anonymous donor in the amount of \$5,000.

### **EXECUTIVE SUMMARY**

The Interim Director of Health and Human Services Agency is authorized for the Acceptance and Disbursement of Gifts, Bequests, or Devices of up to \$1,000 according to Board Resolution No. 05-40. Today's action will allow for the orderly acceptance of an anonymous donation in the amount of \$5,000.

### **ENVIRONMENTAL IMPACT**

ENVIRONMENTAL DETERMINATION: The proposed action is not a project as defined by 14 California Code of Regulations 15378 (State CEQA Guidelines) and therefore CEQA is not applicable.

### **BACKGROUND AND DISCUSSION**

In November 2018 the Health and Human Services Agency (HHSA) received a donation of \$5,000 from an organization that wishes to remain anonymous. The funds are unrestricted and are to be used for the Children's Trust Fund in the Health and Human Services Agency (HHSA).

In 1983, the Legislature passed Assembly Bill 2994, which authorized the creation of a County Children's Trust Fund (CCTF). The purpose of the CCTF is to support child abuse prevention services in the community and to fund child abuse prevention coordinating councils (CAPCs), along with child abuse and neglect prevention and intervention programs. Board Resolution No. 05-40 and the Recommended Procedure for the Acceptance and Disbursement of Gifts, Bequests, or Devices requires that donations in excess of \$1,000 be accepted by the Board of Supervisors.
