SUBJECT:	Consideration and possible approval of a proposed non-profit charitable organization to receive donation from Jayson Woodbridge

# RECOMMENDATION

County Counsel requests consideration and approval of a non-profit charitable organization proposed by Jayson Woodbridge to receive the monetary donation required by the Release and Settlement Agreement.

# EXECUTIVE SUMMARY

In March 2006, the County entered into a Release and Settlement Agreement with Jayson Woodbridge and One True Vine, LLC (Woodbridge) regarding winery operations that occurred without benefit of County required permits. One of the terms of the Settlement Agreement require that Woodbridge donate at least \$100,000 in cash or through fundraising efforts which guarantees at least \$100,000 in gross receipts to no more than two non-profit charitable organizations whose purpose is to benefit Napa County residents as approved by the Board of Supervisors. The first donation of at least \$50,000 is required to occur by December 31, 2006, and the balance donated by December 31, 2007.

The purpose of this item is for the Board to hear, consider and possibly approve one of the non-profit charitable organizations proposed by Woodbridge to receive the monetary donation required by by the terms of the Settlement Agreement.

### BACKGROUND AND DISCUSSION

In March 2006, the County entered into a Release and Settlement Agreement with Jayson Woodbridge and One True Vine, LLC (Woodbridge) regarding winery operations that occurred without benefit of County required permits. One of the terms of the Settlement Agreement require that Woodbridge donate at least \$100,000 in cash or through fundraising efforts which guarantees at least \$100,000 in gross receipts to no more than two non-profit charitable organizations whose purpose is to benefit Napa County residents as approved by the Board of Supervisors. The first donation of at least \$50,000 is required to occur by December 31, 2006, and the balance donated by December 31, 2007.
