SUBJECT: Long Distance Telephone Contract

RECOMMENDATION

Communications Manager requests approval of and authorization for the Chair to sign an agreement with Telekenex for \$0.032 per minute for the term December 1, 2005 through November 30, 2006 for long distance telephone service.

EXECUTIVE SUMMARY

Under this agreement Telekenex will provide vital long distance telephone service for all County telephone users.

ENVIRONMENTAL IMPACT

ENVIRONMENTAL DETERMINATION: The proposed action is not a project as defined by 14 California Code of Regulations 15378 (State CEQA Guidelines) and therefore CEQA is not applicable.

BACKGROUND AND DISCUSSION

The County currently is using Telekenex for all of their Intralata, Interstate, International, Inbound 800, and Calling Card services. After reviewing competitive offers from Telekenex and the other major long distance carrier (SBC), the Telekenex offer constitutes the lowest cost contract for these services. Telekenex has been the provider of these services to the county since September 2001, and have been timely, knowledgeable, courteous, and proactive in their service to the County.

The new contract from Telekenex contains an overall reduction in rates of 42.56%. Current County cost for these services average \$2000 month. Savings will average \$800 per month, or \$9600 annually. These average figures are taken from current long distance bills, and are rounded off because of the nature of fluctuation of long distance usage month to month.
