Association

RECOMMENDATION

Agricultural Commissioner/Sealer of Weights and Measures requests approval of and authorization for the Chair to sign renewal of Agreement No. 180052B (formerly Revenue Agreement No. 7844) with the California Agricultural Commissioners and Sealers Association (CACASA) for a maximum of \$5,028 for the term January 1, 2018 through June 30, 2018 for services related to submitting pesticide use reporting data.

EXECUTIVE SUMMARY

Renewal of Agreement No. 180052B reimburses the County for preparation and submission of pesticide use reporting data. The MOU before the Board will allow CACASA to reimburse the County for time expended by staff collecting, reviewing, and electronically entering pesticide use report information into a statewide database from January 1, 2018 through June 30, 2018. Staff is requesting the agreement be backdated to January 2018 to allow reimbursement to be received beginning in that time period. The agreement was received by the County on January 19, 2018.

BACKGROUND AND DISCUSSION

Agreement No. 180052B provides for reimbursement of costs associated with the Agricultural Commissioner's collecting, reviewing, and electronically entering pesticide use report information and subsequent transferring of data for use by the California Department of Pesticide Regulation. This MOU provides reimbursement of up to \$5,028 for activities related to the pesticide use report submissions.
