SUBJECT: City of Napa Shooting Range

RECOMMENDATION

Chief Probation Officer requests approval of and authorization for the Chair to sign an Agreement with the City of Napa for use of their shooting range at a rate of \$1,000 monthly for the term February 1, 2020 through June 30, 2021 with automatic renewals annually.

EXECUTIVE SUMMARY

The Probation Department is seeking a shooting range for the purposes of firearms training and qualifications for armed sworn personnel. The City of Napa operates a shooting range that is local and meets the needs of the Department.

ENVIRONMENTAL IMPACT

ENVIRONMENTAL DETERMINATION: The proposed action is not a project as defined by 14 California Code of Regulations 15378 (State CEQA Guidelines) and therefore CEQA is not applicable.

BACKGROUND AND DISCUSSION

All sworn, armed probation officers are required to qualify quarterly at a firing range. Additionally, armed officers require relevant, realistic, and regular training with their firearm as it is a perishable skill. Each qualification/training is a minimum of four (4) hours.

The City of Napa's shooting range is able to accommodate the Department's armed officers to meet required quarterly qualifications. The fee is \$1,000 per month invoiced quarterly in arrears.

The Department has a current contract with another government agency to use their firing range however, that agency is unable to accommodate the Department's requested schedule, the range is located in another County and the fees and expenses associated with firearm qualifications are greater.
