BACKGROUND AND DISCUSSION

There is one opening on the Wildlife Conservation Commission (WCC) due to the resignation of the youth representative. The County Executive Office has advertised for the position and received two applications.

The Commission consists of eight members appointed by the Board of Supervisors. The eight members are comprised of four citizen representatives, one sportsperson-angler, one wildlife-conservation representative, one youth, and one Conservation, Development and Planning Commission representative.

The purpose of the WCC is to advise the Board of Supervisors on how funds, including the percentage of Fish and Game fines received by Napa County, should be expended for the preservation, propagation and protection of birds, mammals, fish and amphibians.
