BACKGROUND AND DISCUSSION

Due to a resignation, there is currently one opening appointed by the Board of Supervisors on the Napa County Child Care Planning Council. The County Executive Office has advertised for the vacancy and the only response received was from Mary Welch.

The Napa County Child Care Planning Council was created by resolution of the Board of Supervisors on February 10, 1998 to consist of twenty members. Ten (10) members are appointed by the Board of Supervisors and ten (10) are appointed by the Napa County Superintendent of Schools. The composition must include 20% consumers, 20% child care providers, 20% public agency representatives, 20% community representatives, and 20% at-large members. The purpose of the Council is to assess and prioritize the community's child care and development needs.

As has been past practice, the Executive Committee of the Child Care Planning Council reviewed Ms. Welch's application and recommends appointment.
