#### **EXECUTIVE SUMMARY**

The Compliance Program Quarterly report for the period ending December 31, 2004 provides an overview of the Compliance Program including a summary of the compliance trainings provided at Health and Human Services, a summary of some recent amendments to the federal sentencing guidelines as they relate to the County's compliance program, a brief summary of selected compliance focus areas, and the Compliance Program's planned activities for the next quarter. The compliance focus areas for the quarter included:

- Certification of the Office of Inspector General (OIG) Workplan;
- A repayment of Federal Financial Participation totalling \$11,127 related to the Forensic Conditional Release Program;
- Receipt and investigation into an anonymous memo concerning operations in the Social Services division;
- Completion of the Compliance Program's work regarding the Emergency Medical Services Agency;
