SUBJECT: DECLARATION OF RESULTS OF MEASURE K FROM FEBRUARY 5, 2008 ELECTION

## RECOMMENDATION

Assessor-Recorder-County Clerk requests Board declaration of the results of the Measure K election under its jurisdiction as set forth in the Certified Statement of Vote (Official Canvass) for the Presidential Primary Election held on Tuesday, February 5, 2008 pursuant to the Elections Code Sections 15300-15400.

### **EXECUTIVE SUMMARY**

Election Code Section 15372 provides that the Elections Official shall prepare a certified statement of the results of the election and submit it to the governing body within 28 days of the election. Assessor-Recorder-County Clerk sent the certified statement to the Board of Supervisors on February 25, 2008, which is within the 28 days period.

In addition, Election Code Section 15400 provides that the governing body (Board of Supervisors) shall declare the results of each election under its jurisdiction as to each measure voted at such election.

### **ENVIRONMENTAL IMPACT**

### BACKGROUND AND DISCUSSION

Elections Code Section 15372 provides that the elections official shall prepare a certified statement of the results of the election and submit it to the governing body within 28 days of the election. Assessor-Recorder-County Clerk sent the certified statement to the Board of Supervisors on February 25, 2008, which is within the 28 days period. In addition, Elections Code Section 15400 provides that the governing body (Board of Supervisors) shall declare the results of each election under its jurisdiction as to each measure voted at such election.

For the February 5, 2008 Presidential Primary Election, the Board needs to declare the results of Measure K as set forth in the statement of vote. Measure K, the Stanley Lane Deli Initiative, which required a 50% majority, passed with 57.42% yes votes.

All other contests and propositions on that ballot are to be declared either at the state level or by local municipalities or school districts.
