### ENVIRONMENTAL IMPACT

### BACKGROUND AND DISCUSSION

There are currently two openings on the Wildlife Conservation Commission (WCC) due to the expiration of terms. The County Executive Office has advertised for the positions and have received one request for reappointment.

The Commission consists of eight members appointed by the Board of Supervisors. The eight members are comprised of four citizen representatives, one sportsperson-angler, one wildlife/conservation representative, one youth, and one Conservation, Development and Planning Commission representative. Mr. Rae is applying for reappointment as the wildlife/conservation representative.

The purpose of the WCC is to advise the Board of Supervisors on how funds, including the percentage of California State Department of Fish and Game fines received by Napa County, should be expended for the preservation, propagation and protection of birds, mammals, fish and amphibians.
