BACKGROUND AND DISCUSSION

The Child Abuse Prevention Council, which is mandated in each county by the Welfare and Institutions Code, educates the community on child abuse prevention issues. The Napa County Citizen Review Panel reviews the compliance of HHS's Child Protective Services (CPS) in the discharge of its responsibilities and makes

recommendations to the State and CPS.

The Child Abuse Prevention Council is required to submit an annual report to the local Board of Supervisors. The Citizen Review Panel is required to submit an annual report to the State Department of Social Services, and the State recommends that the report also be presented to the Board of Supervisors. Both CAPC and CRP have chosen March to present their reports to the Board as an introduction to the month of April, which is Child Abuse Prevention Month. Copies of the full reports of both organizations will be available for the public at the Board's meeting.
