ENVIRONMENTAL IMPACT

BACKGROUND AND DISCUSSION

There is currently one opening on the Wildlife Conservation Commission (WCC) due to expiration of term. The County Executive Office has advertised for the position and has received a request from George Carl to be

reappointed to the Sportsperson/Angler position.

The Commission consists of eight members appointed by the Board of Supervisors. The eight members are comprised of four (4) citizen representatives, one (1) sportsperson/angler, one (1) wildlife/conservation representative, one (1) youth, and one (1) Conservation, Development and Planning Commission representative.

The purpose of the WCC is to advise the Board of Supervisors on how funds, including the percentage of California State Department of Fish and Game fines received by Napa County, should be expended for the preservation, propagation and protection of birds, mammals, fish and amphibians.

By taking this action today, the Wildlife Conservation Commission will have a full and complete commission.
