**ADMINISTRATIVE ITEMS** - These items include significant policy and administrative actions and are classified by program areas. Immediately after approval of the CONSENT CALENDAR, if the time for hearing SET MATTERS has not arrived. ADMINISTRATIVE ITEMS will be considered.

## **Human Services**

- **A.** Director of Health and Human Services requests approval of and authorization for the Chair to sign the following agreements to provide counseling services in the Children's Behavioral Health/Child Welfare Services/SB 163 Wraparound Programs:
