## **RECOMMENDATION**

Director of Health and Human Services requests approval of and authorization for the Chairman to sign Amendment No. 5 to Agreement No. 6375 with Victor Treatment Centers, Inc., incorporating specific terms and conditions regarding compliance requirements, amending Section 1.7 of the Terms and Conditions-Contract Administration to include an additional funding source, and incorporating Addenda to the Scope of Work and Compensation sections to add Therapeutic Behavioral Services.

# **EXECUTIVE SUMMARY**

Under its current agreement, Victor Treatment, Inc. provides specialty mental health services for youth placed at its residential treatment facility. Approval of the amendment will:

- incorporate specific terms and conditions regarding compliance requirements;
- amend Section 1.7 of the Terms and Conditions-Contract Administration to add Medi-Cal as a billing source; and
- incorporate Addenda to the Scope of Work and Compensation sections to add Therapeutic Behavioral Services to the list of services offered and allow those services to be billed to Medi-Cal for reimbursement.

Victor Treatment Centers, Inc. is not a local vendor.

## BACKGROUND AND DISCUSSION

Victor Treatment Centers, Inc. provides specialty mental health services and intensive day treatment to Napa County children and youth placed in a residential treatment setting in order to address their mental health needs. Services provided include full-day intensive day treatment services and may also include individual and family psychotherapy, rehabilitation, and other specialty mental health treatment activities. The objective of these services is to promote and support the return of the child or youth to his or her home community after adequate progress has been made.

Approval of the amendment will:

- incorporate specific terms and conditions regarding compliance requirements;
- amend Section 1.7 of the Terms and Conditions-Contract Administration to add Medi-Cal as a billing source; and
- incorporate Addenda to the Scope of Work and Compensation sections to add Therapeutic Behavioral
   Services to the list of services offered and allow those services to be billed to Medi-Cal for reimbursement.
