SUBJECT: Amendment No. 2 to Agreement with Charles Taylor, Ph.D.

RECOMMENDATION

Director of Health and Human Services requests approval of and authorization for the Chair to sign Amendment No. 2 to Agreement No. 6221 with Charles Taylor, Ph.D., increasing the amount by \$8,040 for a new maximum of \$15,000 to provide psychologicial assessments.

EXECUTIVE SUMMARY

Dr. Taylor is a licensed psychologist who provides court-ordered psychological evaluations of Child Protective Services clients. These evaluations are necessary in order to have accurate information with which to make child safety decisions. The amendment increases the maximum dollar amount to provide additional units of court-ordered services for the remainder of this fiscal year.
