SUBJECT: Out of State Travel

RECOMMENDATION

Auditor-Controller requests authorization for out of state travel for Auditor-Controller Pamela Kindig to attend the annual Government Finance Officers Association (GFOA) Conference in San Antonio, Texas, from June 24 - June 30, 2005.

EXECUTIVE SUMMARY

The GFOA is a professional organization of public officials which has the goals of enhancing and promoting the professional management of governmental financial resources by identifying, developing and advancing fiscal strategies, policies and practices for the public benefit. This annual conference is an educational gathering of these governmental professionals to share strategies, policies and practices.
