RECOMMENDATION

First and final reading and adoption of technical cleanup ordinance to:

- 1. Eliminate the Zoning Administrator as the decision maker on use permits in the Industrial Park Zoning District to be consistent with previous ordinances;
- 2. To reflect the change in title from "Fire Warden" to "Fire Chief"; and
- 3. To delete "overlay" in lieu of the more correct wording of "combination" district.

BACKGROUND AND DISCUSSION

The attached ordinance is designed to make minor, non-substantive technical changes to various sections of the Napa County Code.

Section One amends Section 18.40.020 to eliminate the Zoning Administrator as the decision maker on use permits in the Industrial Park zoning district to be consistent with previous ordinances.

Sections Two, Three, and Four amend Sections 18.40.180, 18.44.180, and 18.50.120 to reflect the change in title from "Fire Warden" to "Fire Chief".

Section Five amends Section 18.80.020 to delete "overlay" in lieu of the more correct wording of "combination" district.
