| SUBJECT:          | Delegation of authority to the Treasurer-Tax Collector to invest and re-invest funds held in the County treasury. |

### RECOMMENDATION

County Executive Officer requests adoption of a resolution renewing the delegation of authority granted to the Napa County Treasurer-Tax Collector to invest and re-invest funds held in the County treasury for a one-year period beginning April 1, 2005.

#### EXECUTIVE SUMMARY

In accordance with Government Code Sec. 53607, the Board is to annually renew the delegation of its authority to invest and re-invest funds held in the County Treasury to the Napa County Treasurer-Tax Collector by resolution. The appropriate resolution is attached.

## BACKGROUND AND DISCUSSION

In 1996, the Board passed Ordinance 1103, delegating its authority to invest and re-invest funds held in the County Treasury to the Napa County Treasurer-Tax Collector. This delegation is authorized by Section 27000.1 of the Government Code. The Government Code was subsequently amended, requiring the Board to annually renew the delegation of that authority by resolution (GC Sec. 53607). Today's requested action renews that delegation for the upcoming twelve months.
