BACKGROUND AND DISCUSSION

The Napa County Mental Health Board is comprised of consumers of mental health services, family members of consumers, interested and concerned citizens and a member of the Napa County Board of Supervisors, all appointed by the Board of Supervisors. The assigned functions of the board include the ongoing evaluation of community mental health needs, the review of certain contracts for mental health services entered into by the

county, providing advice and input to the Board of Supervisors and the Mental Health Director on mental health issues, reviewing and approving procedures to ensure continued public input into the planning of mental health services, review and comment on the performance outcomes of mental health services, and assessment of the impacts of the realignment of mental health services from the state to the local level. Each year, Mental Health Board is required to report to the Board of Supervisors on its activities.
