#### BACKGROUND AND DISCUSSION

The Association of Bay Area Governments was established in 1961 and is the oldest Council of Governments in

California. ABAG is the designated regional planning agency for the San Francisco Bay Area and its members include all nine counties and 101 cities in the region. Representatives and alternates from member counties are appointed by the county's Board of Supervisors.

Napa County has one regular and an alternate member who serve on the ABAG Executive Board. Only supervisors are eligible as county members of the Executive Board. Supervisor Mark Luce is the current representative, and the alternate is Supervisor Bill Dodd. Both terms are due to expire June 30, 2007.

The Executive Board meets six times a year bi-monthly at 7:00 p.m. on the third Thursday of the month in Oakland. The next Executive Board meeting is on July 19, 2007.
