### **BACKGROUND AND DISCUSSION**

CalTrans proposes to increase the width of Highway 29 south of the City of St. Helena. The project will add a two-

way left-turn lane from just south of Galleron Lane to just north of Grayson Avenue in the City of St. Helena. CalTrans staff is here today to present the project to the Board of Supervisors, and to the public.

The project was first proposed in the early 1990's, but became delayed when problems in gaining adequate Right of Way were encountered. Circumstances have changed, and CalTrans is now moving forward with the project.
