SUBJECT: Amendment 2 of Agreement 6530 with Timothy Hoyt for Fire Inspection Services

RECOMMENDATION

County Fire Chief requests approval of and authorization for the Chair to sign Amendment No. 2 to Agreement No. 6530 with Timothy Hoyt increasing the amount by \$30,000 for a new maximum of \$110,000 and extending the term through September 30, 2006.

EXECUTIVE SUMMARY

The County Fire Marshal's Office is responsible for fire-related inspection of building projects in the unincorporated areas of Napa County. This agreement will augment the staff during the convalescence of an injured inspector.

Mr. Hoyt has the necessary expertise and has been assisting the Fire Marshal's staff with these duties.
