RECOMMENDATION

Director of Health and Human Services requests approval of and authorization for the Chair to sign the following renewal agreements to provide inpatient psychiatric services for the term July 1, 2005 through June 30, 2006:

- 1. Agreement No. 6161 with Steven E. Shaw, M.D. for a maximum of \$5,000;
- 2. Agreement No. 6179 with Kiran Koka, M.D., for a maximum of \$5,000; and
- 3. Agreement No. 6274 with Margaret Grimley, M.D, for a maximum of \$7,500.

EXECUTIVE SUMMARY

The contractors provide psychiatric mental health services to inpatient clients at Mt. Diablo Medical Pavillion hospital.

BACKGROUND AND DISCUSSION

In January 1995, HHSA implemented the inpatient phase of the Mental Health Managed Care Program. The program is governed by the terms of Agreement No. 4028 with the State Department of Mental Health, regulations promulgated by the Federal Medicaid and California Medi-Cal programs, and by a provider operations manual developed by HHSA staff and reviewed by County Counsel. Costs are funded by a State managed care allocation.

The County contracts with four hospitals for inpatient services. The contract with Mt. Diablo does not include physician services. This agreement provides for the physician portion of the inpatient stay at Mt. Diablo.

The department has executed Business Associate agreements on file with these providers.
